## How to book

School Led clubs booking will open on Arbor under 'Clubs' at 7pm on Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> January.

Please only select one club however you may book the following clubs in addition to your selection Singing Club, Homework Club or Cross Country.

\*If a chargeable club is booked without payment this membership will be deleted without notification, ensure you make payment straight away\*

\*If you are unable to select a membership period during your booking this indicates the club is now FULL\* To check your booking has been made please look under "Clubs your child is registered for". At the time of booking Arbor will also confirm you have successfully booked.

To book externally run clubs you will need to contact the provider directly. Details on pg. 12.

## Club charges

In line with other schools in the Trust, we will be implementing a termly charge of £9.00 for each teacher-led after school club, per child, per term. This will help contribute towards the running costs of our after-school programme. This works out at only £1 a week and will also help to purchase and replenish resources to support the

wide variety of clubs on offer, whilst providing an hours extra childcare provision as the finishing time for all teacher led after school clubs will be 4:15pm.

Lunchtime and morning clubs will continue to be free of charge.

As part of our Pupil Premium offer, pupils in receipt of Pupil Premium will have all clubs they attend, funded. In addition, we operate a concession for families with 3 or more children so that only the eldest two children are paid for. (If this applies to you, please register your third child without making payment at the time of booking & email the school office to notify them).

### Where to collect/drop off

Unless otherwise specified, children attending school clubs should be dropped off and collected from the courtyard area outside the school office on Magdalen Meadows.
