These are the topics we will be covering in the next few weeks...

<b>English</b>	Playscript writing linked to our class text, Stig of the Dump, and then short Poetry (Kennings and Limericks).
<b>Maths</b>	Length and Perimeter Fractions
<b>Science</b>	Light and Shadows – looking at shadows, light sources and reflective surfaces.
<b>History</b>	The children are continuing to learn about British prehistory with the focus shifting to the Bronze Age and then the Iron Age.
<b>Computing</b>	Online communication (emailing)
<b>PE</b>	Swimming and fitness
<b>Health and Wellbeing</b>	Rights and Respect - being sensible with money, volunteering, making a positive change.
